LOCATION

Situated midway along the Devon and Cornwall coastline, Sutton Harbour Marina is perfectly placed at the centre of some of the UK's finest cruising grounds.

The tidal rivers Tamar and Yealm are close by, while Salcombe and Dartmouth to the east, and Fowey and Falmouth to the west, are all within a day's sail.

Sutton Harbour Marina is Plymouth's historic waterfront district, boasting a range of attractions and is an excellent base for exploring the rest of Britain's Ocean City.

On your doorstep you will find narrow cobbled streets, Elizabethan houses, specialist shops, art galleries, cafés, bars, and restaurants. From here you can discover the Mayflower Steps where the Pilgrims set sail for the New World or take a short stroll to Plymouth Hoe with its breathtaking views over Plymouth Sound, Drake's Island and Mount Edgcumbe Country Park.

Walk to Plymouth City Centre, where Drake Circus Shopping Centre and the brand new Barcode entertainment complex offer high-street shopping, top restaurants, IMAX cinema and adventure golf. Plymouth's Theatre Royal and Barbican Leisure Park, with its 15-screen cinema, are also a short walk away.

You will be just a moment's walk to the National Marine Aquarium, the UK's largest aquarium, and to Plymouth Gin, the oldest working gin distillery in England, founded in 1793.

BY ROAD: The M5 and A38 Devon Expressway connect with the national motorway network, with the postcode for sat nav systems PL4 0DW.

RAIL: Mainline rail services are available to Plymouth Rail Station, a five minute taxi ride or 20 minute walk from Sutton Harbour Marina.

BY SEA: Sutton Harbour Marina can be found at Lat: 50° 21' .98N Long: 04° 07' .96W The marina is accessible by sea via Sutton Lock, situated to the east side of Plymouth Waterfront. The lock is free, staffed 24 hours a day, and operational upon request.
